CITY OF SOUTHFIELD
NORTHBOUND M-10/ NORTHWESTERN HWY
SERVICE DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION

Tentative Key Construction Dates – these are project and weather dependent

Start - Tentative May 26, 2015

Completion – July 30, 2015

Stage 1 – 8 Mile Road to Southfield Road

NB Service Drive is closed and will be detoured. Ramp from 9 Mile to Southfield Rd. will remain accessible throughout construction. All areas except intersections will undergo pavement removals, removal of existing asphalt surface, curb removal, storm sewer installations, pavement repairs, placement of asphalt, driveways to be reconstructed, signal and sidewalk upgrades. The intersections of Northland Dr., JL Hudson, and North Park will remain open for through traffic; however the Service Drive will remain closed.

Stage 2A & 2B – 8 Mile Road to Southfield Road

NB Service Drive will continue to be closed and detoured. All intersections will undergo pavement removals, curb removal, storm sewer installations, pavement repairs, placement of asphalt, driveways to be reconstructed, signal and sidewalk upgrades. Each intersection is anticipated to take two weeks of work under closure to complete before re-opening.

Stage 3 – 8 Mile Road to Southfield Road

NB Service Drive will continue to be closed and detoured. Placement of asphalt wearing (top) course and restoration.

Project Description

1.43 miles on NB Northwestern Highway Service Drive from 8 Mile Road to 9 Mile Road including the ramp from 9 Mile Road north to Southfield Road. The project will reduce the service drive from three lanes to two lanes, creating more green space on the eastern half of the roadway. The existing asphalt overlay will be milled off and new asphalt will be placed, except the three bridge intersections which will be fully reconstructed in asphalt. Sidewalk connectivity to the SB Service Drive will be

improved and ADA compliant sidewalks will be placed at each intersection/driveway crossing. The traffic signals at the 8 Mile and 9 Mile Road intersections will be upgraded.

Northbound M-10 (The Lodge Freeway) Exits 14A and 14B will be completely closed during construction in order to complete work by the contract completion date.

One water main shutdown is necessary to relocate a hydrant and it will be coordinated with the properties affected. The businesses affected can expect written notice of water shut downs with the exception of emergency repairs. More information will be forwarded on this issue in the future.

Project Detours

There will be significant traffic impacts during the construction of this project.

Stage 1 - NB M-10/Northwestern Hwy Service Drive traffic in the project corridor will be prohibited. Traffic will not be able to get to the northbound Service Drive from northbound M-10 or from 8 Mile as barricades will block access. Traffic will be detoured from 8 Mile to Greenfield north, to 9 Mile west to access interior roads that provide access to all properties typically accessed from the Service Drive. The intersections of Northland Dr., JL Hudson, and North Park will remain open to traffic during the reconstruction of the mainline; while the Service Drive remains closed.

Stage 2A & Stage 2B - The work at the intersections will take place in two parts during Stage 2A and Stage 2B. Northland Dr. intersection reconstruction will take place during Stage 2A and is anticipated to be completed within 2 weeks. J.L. Hudson and North Park intersection reconstructions will take place during Stage 2B and is also anticipated to be completed within 2 weeks. Closure continues for the Service Drive with posted detours utilizing Greenfield.

Stage 3 - Closure continues for the Service Drive with posted detours utilizing Greenfield. Bridge intersections open with short closures as asphalt is paved, rolled and cooled.

No work will be permitted during the Memorial Day, or July 4th holiday periods.
