WHEREAS, in 2006 the Michigan State Legislature amended the Michigan Liquor Control Code (Public Act 58 of 1998, as amended) to allow the Michigan Liquor Control Commission to issue additional on-premises liquor licenses to businesses that are located in a redevelopment project area ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Southfield would like to use this tool to promote economic growth and development within the redevelopment project area and the City of Southfield City Council agrees with this request.

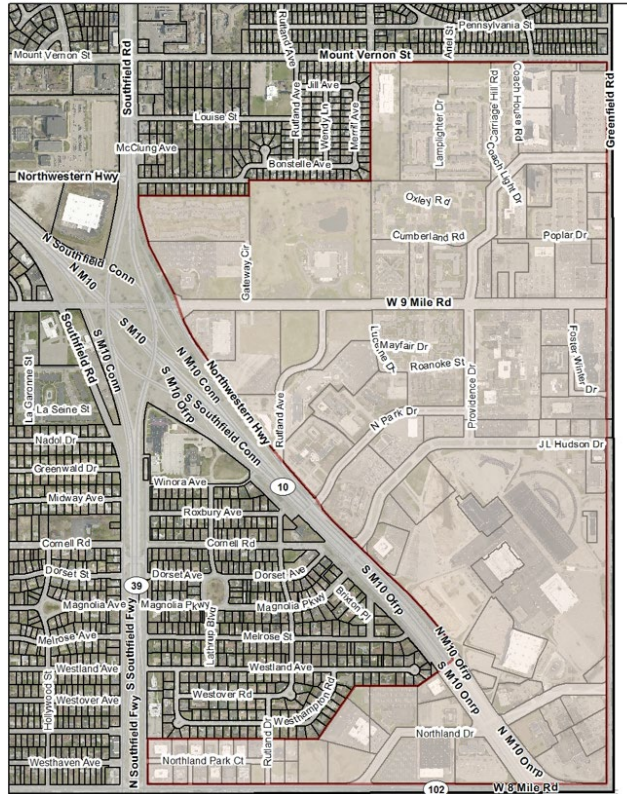
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the City of Southfield City Council hereby resolves that:

The City of Southfield Downtown Development Authority District is hereby designated and established as a Redevelopment Project Area pursuant to Public Act 501 of 2006.

That attached hereto as Exhibit A is the Map of the Redevelopment Project Area.

Further, the City Clerk shall obtain an Affidavit from the Assessor stating the total amount of public and private investment in real and personal property within the redevelopment project area within the past three years. Thereafter the Clerk shall submit the Assessor Affidavit and this Resolution to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission so that the Commission may establish the number of liquor licenses for which the city is entitled to under the Act 501 of 2006.
